The information describes First Nations vaccines that have been recorded in PHIMS as of October 26, 2023. Since many communities do not have access to PHIMS directly we know many more doses have been administered in the communities but have not yet been recorded in PHIMS. We continue to work to address the delay so that the numbers we report more accurately reflect the excellent work going on in communities.

Total Doses Administered

Total number of vaccinations: **335,527**

- 4477 First Nations received 5 doses
- 13,382 First Nations received 4 doses
- 45,993 First Nations received 3 doses
- 129,288 First Nations people received 2 doses
- 142,069 First Nations people received 1 dose

Doses by Vaccine Type:

- COVID 19: Moderna vaccination: **181,555**
- COVID 19: Pfizer vaccination: **150,927**
- COVID-19: Janssen: **88**
