

# COVID19 Vaccination Report

## Manitoba First Nations Pandemic Response Coordination Team



There is now an infant COVID-19 vaccine available for children aged 6 months to 4 years in each community. Call your Nursing station or Health Centre for more information.

### Date: March 15, 2023

The information describes First Nations vaccines that have been recorded in PHIMS as of March 8, 2023. Since many communities do not have access to PHIMS directly we know many more doses have been administered in the communities but have not yet been recorded in PHIMS. We continue to work to address the delay so that the numbers we report more accurately reflect the excellent work going on in communities.

#### Total Doses Administered

Total number of vaccinations: **328,996**

- 12,667 First Nations received 4 doses
- 45,372 First Nations received 3 doses
- 129,103 First Nations people received 2 doses
- 141,853 First Nations people received 1 dose

#### Doses by Vaccine Type:

- COVID 19: Moderna vaccination: **177,256**
- COVID 19: Pfizer vaccination: **148,698**
- COVID-19: AstraZeneca: **2942**
- COVID-19: Janssen: **88**
