

# COVID19 Vaccination Report

## Manitoba First Nations Pandemic Response Coordination Team

### Date: September 21, 2023

The information describes First Nations vaccines that have been recorded in PHIMS as of September 21, 2023. Since many communities do not have access to PHIMS directly we know many more doses have been administered in the communities but have not yet been recorded in PHIMS. We continue to work to address the delay so that the numbers we report more accurately reflect the excellent work going on in communities.

#### Total Doses Administered

Total number of vaccinations: **333,166**

- **3385** First Nations received 5 doses
- **12,971** First Nations received 4 doses
- **45,624** First Nations received 3 doses
- **129,220** First Nations people received 2 doses
- **141,949** First Nations people received 1 dose

- COVID 19: Moderna vaccination: **179,220**
- COVID 19: Pfizer vaccination: **150,903**
- COVID-19: AstraZeneca: **2942**
- COVID-19: Janssen: **88**
