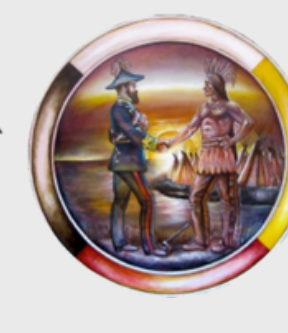

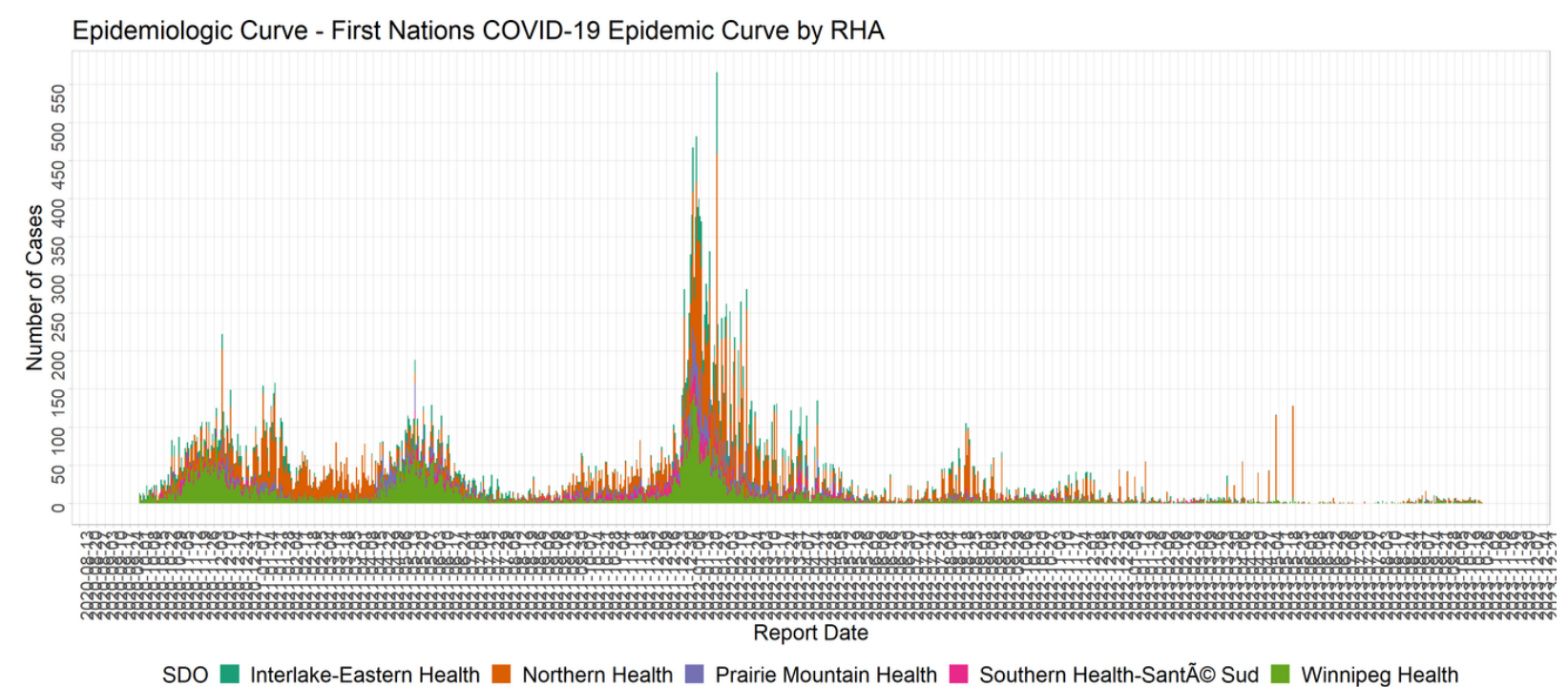

This summary report is intended to provide daily high-level analysis of COVID-19 testing and disease in First Nations people living in Manitoba. The last daily report provided was on October 25, 2023. These numbers do not include all Rapid Antigen Tests positive results so numbers reflected below are an undercount of COVID positive cases. Please note that some of the new cases include data from cleaning up the data entry backlogs.

- Total FN cases: 42,229
 - On Reserve: 25,569
 - Off Reserve: 16,660
- Percentage of total MB population: 27%

For the purposes of this report, First Nations people are identified through a variety of mechanisms. This is because not any one method generates a complete list of the First Nations population in Manitoba. The mechanisms used are:

- PHINs of cases and tested individuals are matched up to Status First Nations in the Indian Status Registry - ISR. This list is current as of June 2020.
- Self-report in the course of the COVID case investigation.
- Manual review of familial linkages identified in the course of COVID case investigations. Linkages are made by reported relationships, shared last names or addresses, and only counts horizontal- sibling - or downward - offspring - linkages.

Data corrections or updates can result in case records being removed and/or updated and may result in totals different from past publicly reported case counts.
