

# COVID19 Vaccination Report

## Manitoba First Nations Pandemic Response Coordination Team



There is now an infant COVID-19 vaccine available for children aged 6 months to 4 years in each community. Call your Nursing station or Health Centre for more information.

### Date: November 18, 2022

The information describes First Nations vaccines that have been recorded in PHIMS as of November 18, 2022. Since many communities do not have access to PHIMS directly we know many more doses have been administered in the communities but have not yet been recorded in PHIMS. We continue to work to address the delay so that the numbers we report more accurately reflect the excellent work going on in communities.

#### Total Doses Administered

Total number of vaccinations: **323,115**

- 9364 First Nations received 4 doses
- 43,750 First Nations received 3 doses
- 128,646 First Nations people received 2 doses
- 141,354 First Nations people received 1 dose

#### Doses by Vaccine Type:

- COVID 19: Moderna vaccination: **174,825**
- COVID 19: Pfizer vaccination: **145,251**
- COVID-19: AstraZeneca: **2941**
- COVID-19: Janssen: **88**

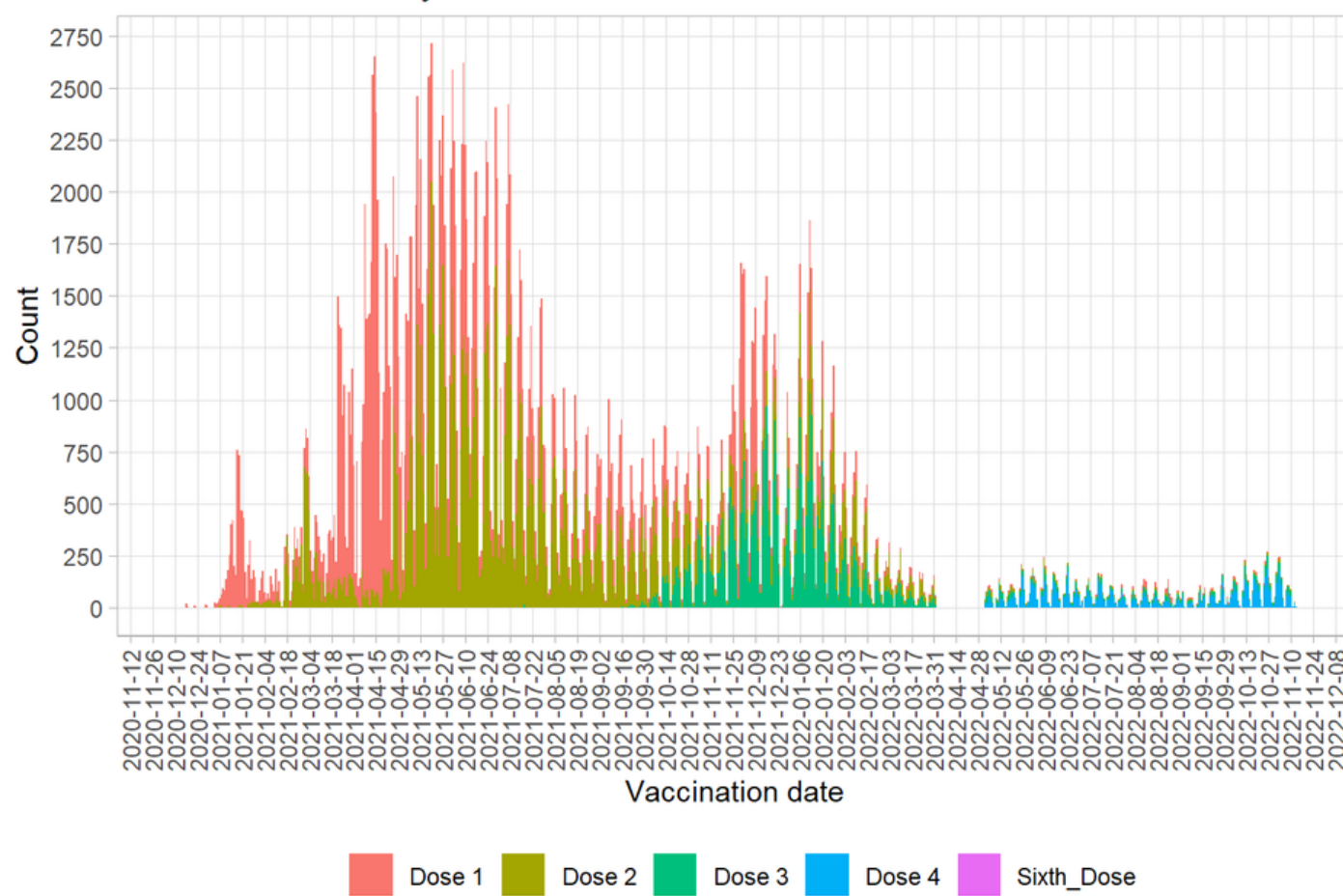

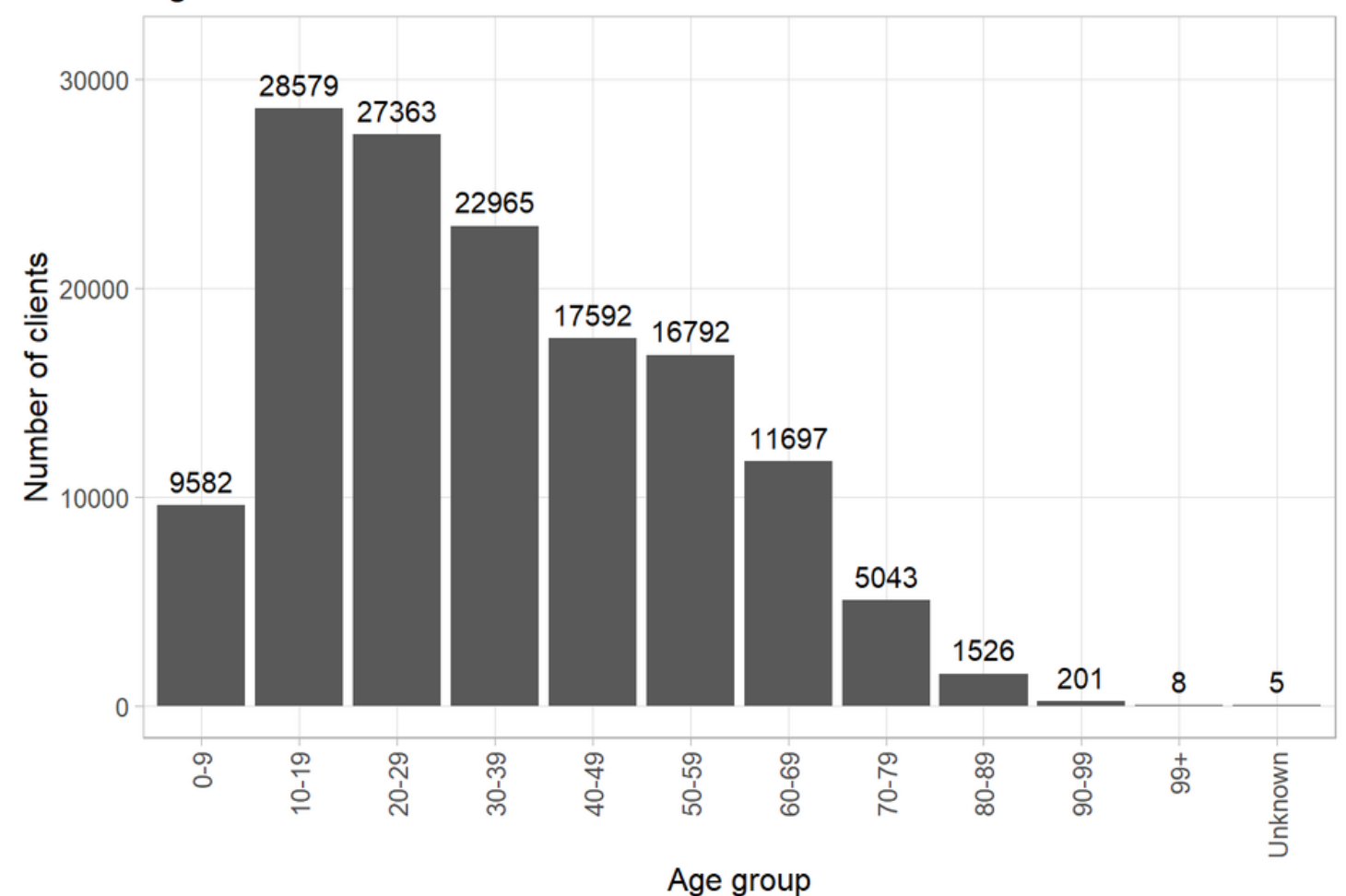
#### Distribution- sex



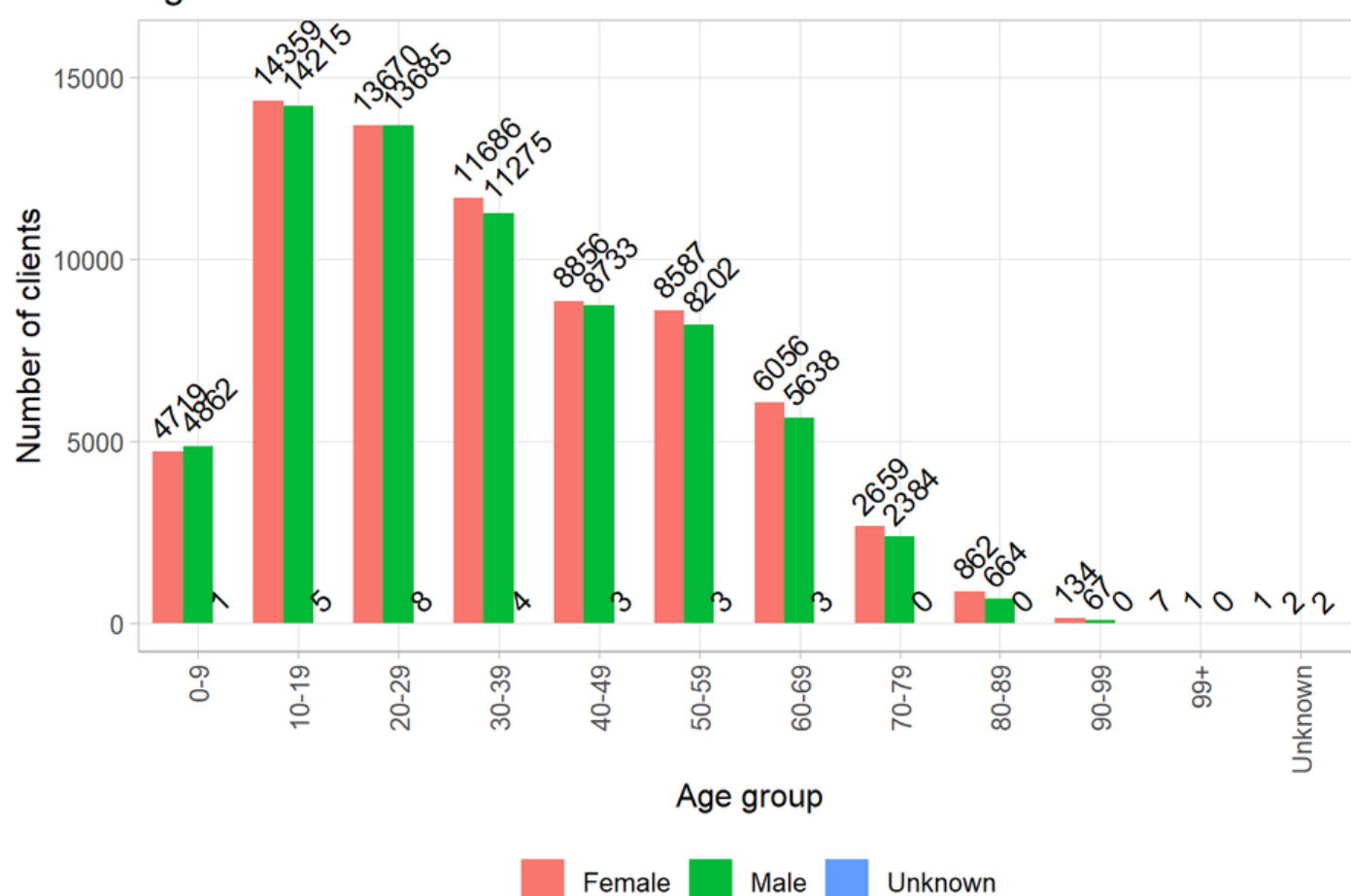
Vaccination curve by dose
