

# COVID19 Vaccination Report

## Manitoba First Nations Pandemic Response Coordination Team



Fall COVID-19 booster and flu vaccines will be available in October. Contact your health center or nursing station for more info.

### Date: January 10, 2024

The information describes First Nations vaccines that have been recorded in PHIMS as of January 10, 2024. Since many communities do not have access to PHIMS directly we know many more doses have been administered in the communities but have not yet been recorded in PHIMS. We continue to work to address the delay so that the numbers we report more accurately reflect the excellent work going on in communities.

### Total Doses Administered

Total number of vaccinations: **342,442**

- 7,173 First Nations received 5 doses
- 16,079 First Nations received 4 doses
- 47,323 First Nations received 3 doses
- 129,490 First Nations people received 2 doses
- 142,357 First Nations people received 1 dose

### Doses by Vaccine Type:

- COVID 19: Moderna vaccination: **186,830**
- COVID 19: Pfizer vaccination: **152,651**
- COVID-19: Janssen: **88**




### Distribution- sex




Vaccination curve by dose
